The Columbus Chain can be a wee bit tricky, so the super newbie may want to steer clear.. but only for now! STUDENTS MUST BRING OR PURCHASE 2 CHAIN NOSE OR 2 FLAT NOSE OR ONE OF EACH OF EITHER PLIER

SATURDAY AUGUST 21ST - 11:30AM - 1:30PM JEN'S PIND CHAIN MAILLE

A long anticipated classic! Jen's Pind is an impressive weave using a thick ring ratio. Sterling is ideal for a seriously chunky piece, or work with smaller bronze rings for an intriguing and somewhat delicate chain. *Previous chain maille experience is required.* STUDENTS MUST BRING OR PURCHASE: 2 CHAIN NOSE OR 2 BENT CHAIN NOSE PLIERS OR ONE OF EACH PLIER.
